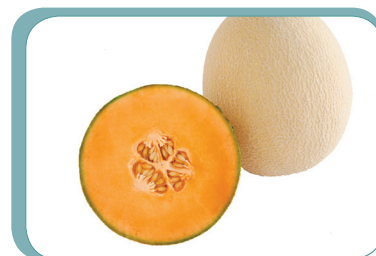
Apollo

This pumpkin is an early maturing, large sized round to tall, with medium-orange color. Apollo has an improved handle size attachment and medium ribbing. With an 18- to 32-pound average weight, it has intermediate resistance to powdery mildew.



Marquette

This Supersweet Bi-Color has a strong upright plant, excellent tip fill, and excellent eating quality. It holds well in the field and has high yield potential. It matures in about 76 days.



Origami

Origami has a vigorous plant with good sunburn protection. It is an early maturing, high-yielding variety that is easy to pick with full slip harvest capability. With uniform 9's and 12's it delivers consistent quality. It has good color, firmness, high Brix, and an outstanding flavor profile. It is also adapted for fresh-cut processors.



Red Bounty

Red Bounty is a determinate round tomato with a vigorous strong plant and good foliage cover, heat set, and a high yield. It produces extra-large, smooth, and uniform fruit of good quality. Red Bounty has intermediate resistance to tomato spotted wilt virus.



Respect

Respect is a high-yielding green zucchini squash with good earliness and a vigorous open plant for easy harvest. Respect produces excellent fruit quality and has good virus resistance.



Sequoia R

This Ancho pepper is early maturing with large and heavy fruits. It is a mild-to-hot pepper that has a strong mid-tall habit plant with wide adaptability. It has high yield potential with uniform fruit size from the beginning to the end of harvest.



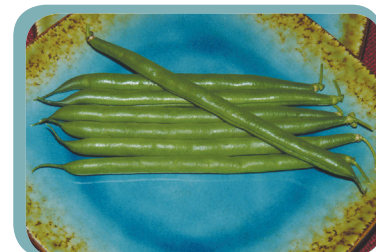
Smarty

Sweet and tasty describe this grape tomato. A manageable indeterminate vine with short internodes and great yield potential, the elongated fruits have good firmness, excellent uniformity, and a red color. Smarty's long shelf life also separate it from the competition.



Troubadour

This Crimson Sweet variety offers high sugars with attractive interior appearance, deep-red flesh color, and good overall eating quality. A strong vine habit and mid-early relative maturity provide high yield potential. Blocky fruit shape coupled with 14- to 17-pound fruit weight allow for a higher bin count.



Wyatt

Wyatt has good plant vigor and an upright habit. Giving consistently high yields of attractive, dark, four-sieve, straight pods, Wyatt matures in about 54 days. It has high resistance to bean common mosaic virus, beet curly top virus, bacterial brown spot, halo blight, and common blight.
